### **REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP) NO. DE-SOL-0001970**

This letter transmits RFP No. DE-SOL-0001970 for the disposal of Low-Level and Mixed-Low-Level Waste, 11e2 byproduct material, Technology Enhanced Naturally Occurring Radioactive Material (TENORM) and Sealed Sources. This letter provides only a summary of the salient elements of the RFP and is not an integral part of this RFP. In the event of any conflict between this letter and the RFP, the RFP shall prevail. Offerors are cautioned to examine carefully and read the entire RFP.

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), Environmental Management Consolidated Business Center (EMCBC) is requesting qualified business to submit proposals to provide all necessary facilities, equipment, personnel materials, supplies, services and shall secure and maintain all necessary permits and licenses in order to perform the services and prepare the deliverables including, but not limited to, taking title to and disposing of the wastes and waste residuals delivered to the Contractor by DOE (including the National Nuclear Security Administration, Laboratories and Project Offices), and any DOE Prime Contractor or Subcontractor to a DOE Prime Contractor performing environmental cleanup services for DOE prime contractors, including sampling and analysis of waste and waste residuals, preparing various instruments of conveyance (trucks, containers, and railcars) for return to the generator of wastes delivered under the contract, and recording and reporting data relative to performance under the contract.

Award(s) may be made to a single and/or multiple Offeror(s) for each CLIN on the basis of best value to the government, i.e. the lowest evaluated price(s) of the proposals meeting or exceeding acceptability criteria for all non-cost criteria for the CLIN(s) proposed. An Offeror may be awarded a contract with a single CLIN, multiple CLIN(s) or all CLIN(s).

Proposals will be evaluated in accordance with the evaluation criteria in Section M of the RFP and applicable Federal laws and regulations. Section L provides detailed proposal preparation instructions to Offerors. The Offeror's initial proposal should contain the Offeror's best terms from a price and technical standpoint.



All recipients of the RFP are cautioned to contact only the designated DOE point of contact (William Hensley) regarding this solicitation until after contract award.

No pre-proposal conference is planned for this solicitation. Questions concerning this solicitation must be submitted via email within 30 calendar days after the release of the RFP. Questions submitted after that date may not allow the Government sufficient time to respond.
