1. Do barriers exist (DOE imposed or otherwise) that would hinder your firm from participating in this acquisition?
2. If your firm anticipates teaming with one or more subcontractors for the performance of the work, is the \$700K dollar threshold for “major or critical subcontractors” reasonable (see Section L.1)?
3. What are the important discriminating factors DOE should consider in making this selection?
4. Does the Draft RFP and the procurement website contain all of the information you need to reasonably estimate the cost of the work detailed in the PWS?
5. What other suggestions do you have?
