Subject: ANNUAL REVIEW OF MEMORANDUMS OF UNDERSTANDING

Dear Mr. Sahd:

WTS Emergency Management has reviewed the following Memorandums of Understanding (MOUs) to determine if revisions are necessary. The law enforcement MOUs are reviewed and revised by Santa Fe Protective Services; therefore are not listed here.

- **Mutual Aid Fire Fighting Agreement with The Eddy County Commission** does not need to be revised.
- **Mutual Aid Agreement with the City of Carlsbad** does not need to be revised.
- **Memorandum of Understanding with the Carlsbad Medical Center** is in revision due to a change in the equipment list.
- **Joint Powers Agreement between the DOE, City of Carlsbad, County of Eddy, the New Mexico Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department for a Joint-Use Alternate Emergency Office Center (EOC)** needs to be cancelled. The Alternate EOC has been relocated to the Skeen Whitlock Building. A letter recommending cancellation of this agreement was sent previously to the CBFO.
- **Mutual Aid Agreement with the City of Hobbs** does not need to be revised.
- **Memorandum of Understanding with Lea Regional Medical Center** - is in revision due to a change in the equipment list.
- **Intrepid Potash NM LLC and Mosaic Potash Carlsbad Inc.** does not need to be revised.

The Memorandums of Agreement between CBFO and the Albuquerque Field Office; the MOU between the Department of Energy (DOE) and the U.S. Department of Interior; the Interagency Agreement between the DOE, Bureau Land of Management, National Park Service, and United States Forrest Service; and the Interagency Agreement between the DOE and the Department of Defense are not part of the WTS Emergency Management review.

Dear Mr. Galle:

WTS Emergency Management has completed a review of the current Memorandums of Understanding (MOU) regarding Emergency Management. As a result of the review, there are two recommendations:

- It is recommended that the MOU between the DOE/CBFO and the New Mexico Energy, Minerals, and Natural Resources Department for locating the Alternate Emergency Operations Center (EOC) at the Living Desert State Park be terminated. This should be completed by written notification from the CBFO.
 - The Alternate EOC at the Living Desert location was adequate; however, with your concurrence, the Alternate EOC has been moved to the Skeen-Whitlock Building. This allows intranet access to the computers, WIPP site phone access, and security in the event the Alternate EOC has to be activated.
- As a result of the company name change from "Westinghouse TRU Solutions" to "Washington TRU Solutions," a letter will be drafted by WTS notifying all MOUs of the change. This will be completed by February 15, 2003.
