<p><b>1.0 ROLE</b></p> <p>The Surface Management Council (SMC) will coordinate and maintain the Landlord Program (Management Policy 5.16), and address surface facility safety-related issues. The SMC will meet at a minimum once every quarter to oversee landlord participation and address surface facility safety issues in an effort to enhance the achievement of the Washington TRU Solutions LLC (WTS) mission.</p> <p><b>2.0 MEMBERSHIP</b></p> <p>The SMC will solicit participation from members of the primary site participants. The SMC will be chaired by a Site Operations and Disposal section manager appointed by the Site Operations and Disposal Manager. The following additional positions will make up the SMC:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Site Security Manager</li> <li>• WTS Industrial Safety and Hygiene Manager</li> <li>• WTS Landlord Coordinator (as designated by the Site Operations and Disposal Manager)</li> <li>• WTS Engineering representative</li> <li>• WTS Quality Assurance Project Integration representative</li> <li>• WTS nonexempt representative</li> <li>• Landlords as specified or as invited</li> </ul> <p>The Site Operations and Disposal section manager, Industrial Safety and Hygiene Manager, and Landlord Coordinator (or their designees) must be present for a quorum.</p>	

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<p><b>3.0    RESPONSIBILITIES</b></p> <p>The SMC will oversee the Landlord Program.</p> <p>The SMC will interface with other established committees, section management, and department management to identify areas for improvement.</p> <p><b>4.0    AUTHORITY</b></p> <p>The SMC is empowered to resolve safety and other surface management related issues. Decisions are based on the consensus of all members and are binding on the Landlord Program. Resolution of safety issues is also by consensus of all members.</p>
