<p><b>1.0 POLICY</b></p> <p>Washington TRU Solutions LLC (WTS) is committed to meeting its contractual obligations to the Department of Energy (DOE). Section J, Attachment H, List B of the WTS Prime Contract with the U.S. DOE Carlsbad Field Office (CBFO) is modified with the concurrence of WTS and CBFO to delete or add new and/or modified DOE Directives, Orders, Manuals, and Notices.
