The Site Operations and Disposal Department manager is also responsible for the implementation of and compliance with this policy for general purpose facilities and for site infrastructure under Operations' responsibility.</p> <p>3.2 Facility Inspections</p> <p>The Site Operations and Disposal Department manager has delegated coordination of facility inspections to Maintenance Operations. Inspections consist of examinations of real property at WIPP to determine the overall condition and to identify any significant maintenance and repair required to keep or to put the property in a state of good repair. Inspection frequency of each facility is established according to its age, condition, use, and functional importance.
