SUBJECT: Delegation of Safety Authorities

This memorandum serves as your delegation of safety related authorities listed in the Attachment and supersedes those delegated by prior memorandum. This update is made in accordance with the Office of Environmental Management (EM) Standing Operating Policy and Procedure (SOPP) # 44, *Environmental Management Process for Delegation of Safety Authorities*.

Designated authorities assigned through Department of Energy (DOE) Directives are established to ensure objective and consistent decision making by appropriate levels of line management. Decisions and associated actions must be consistent with the policy and goals of this organization. If you have any questions in executing your authorities, I encourage you to seek input from me before you take an action or make a decision.

Our record shows that you have not completed your Senior Technical Safety Manager certification and the Nuclear Executive Leadership Training, in accordance with SOPP #44; consequently, your delegated safety authorities have been limited to a few functions. I encourage you to complete these required training at the next available sessions and forward a copy of your certificates to my office with a copy to B. K. Singh (EM-21).

Unless otherwise specified, none of these authorities may be re-delegated without my prior approval. I am willing to consider further delegations based upon review of a specific delegation plan that describes how each authority or like authorities can be carried out while maintaining intended objectivity and consistency with the EM program and DOE policies and goals. The authorities listed in the Attachment will expire on January 31, 2012.

List of Authorities Delegated to Kevin Bazzell, Acting Federal Project Director for Oakland Projects Office

1. DOE O 414.1C, 5.b.(8): Provide the contracting officer the necessary information and direction in order to specify the requirements for flow-down of provisions of the Contractor Requirements Document (CRD) to subcontractors or sub-awards, and provisions of the CRD with which contractors or subcontractors are to comply.
2. DOE O 231.1A, 5.c.(3)(a), and DOE M 231.1-2, 4.2.a and e: Serve as Program Manager which includes authority for implementing the occurrence reporting requirements and ensuring that training programs are established for both DOE and contractor personnel.
3. DOE O 252.1:

5.b(2): Designate a Technical Standards Manager (TSM) to serve as the organization's point of contact for technical standards activities.

5.b(4): Preferentially use appropriate voluntary consensus standards in lieu of developing internal Technical Standards to support DOE missions and functions.
4. DOE O 433.1B, 5.a(2): For Government-owned and Government-operated (GOGO) activities, serve as approval authority for nuclear maintenance management program documents prepared in accordance with the Contractor Requirements Document (CRD), Attachment 1.
