	Section	Question	Response
1.	Section L.31 Criterion 1, Past Performance	If an Offeror is submitting an offer under the definition of FAR 9.601(2) in a prime/subcontractor teaming arrangement, where the subcontractor is anticipated to perform work with a value less than \$5M over the contract period, is the subcontractor who is in the teaming arrangement with the offeror required to submit their Past Performance and Experience and will it be evaluated?	If the subcontractor is a part of the formal contractor teaming arrangement with a teaming agreement, the Offeror shall submit an Attachment L-3, Past Performance and Relevant Experience Reference Information Form for three (3) contracts or projects for each entity comprising the teaming arrangement.
2.	Section L.31 Criterion 1, Past Performance	If the Offeror was the Prime Contractor under a contract not performed for DOE-EM, but that has CPARS/PPIRS reports available, do we also need to submit an L-4 Past Performance Questionnaire or will the CPARS/PPIRS data be sufficient?	Yes, the questionnaires must be submitted. The Offeror, each entity comprising the teaming arrangement, and each major subcontractor shall forward the Attachment L-4, Past Performance Letter and Questionnaire, to the appropriate point of contact for each contract or project cited on an Attachment L-3 for which the entity performed as a prime and which was not performed for the DOE Office of Environmental Management (EM).
3.	Section L.27, Time, Date, and Place Offers and Proposal Information are Due	Please clarify what constitutes delivery of the proposal. Is the Offeror compliant if the electronic submittal arrives in time via fedconnect or does physical delivery of the hard copies have to be made for the proposal to be considered on time?	Per section L.27 (a), all Offers and Proposal Information, including the official electronic submission and the three written proposal volumes, must be received on or before May 14, 2015 by 4:00 p.m. Eastern Time . Therefore, both written and electronic proposal copies have to be submitted by this date and time to be considered “on-time.”
