Subject: Construction of Additional 90 Day Hazardous Waste  
Accumulation Yards at SSFL

Dear Mr. Agarwal:

This letter is a follow-up to past conversations held between DTSC and Boeing pertaining to the establishment of two additional 90 day hazardous waste accumulation yards at Boeing's Santa Susana Field Laboratory (SSFL). After discussion with representatives from NASA and the DOE, all parties are in agreement to establish two new 90 day hazardous waste yards for the collection and shipment of wastes generated by NASA and DOE operations. Under this agreement, Boeing will continue to operate the existing hazardous waste yard in Area III. This waste yard will be used for the collection and shipment of all hazardous waste generated by Boeing at SSFL and shipped under EPA ID number CAD093365435. A second 90 day waste accumulation yard will be established in Area II of SSFL, an area owned by NASA. Waste generated by NASA in all areas of SSFL under EPA ID CA1800090010 will be shipped to this new waste yard for accumulation, consolidation and offsite shipment.

A third waste yard will be established in Area IV of SSFL. This yard will be used to ship hazardous waste generated from DOE operations under EPA ID CA3890090001.

Work has already commenced to upgrade two existing facilities into these 90-day hazardous waste accumulation yards, and your agency will be notified as soon as they become operational.
