Pre-solicitation Conference, Site Tour & Industry One-on-One Sessions

The US Department of Energy's (DOE) Environmental Management Consolidated Business Center, Cincinnati, Ohio is conducting a procurement to acquire services for environmental monitoring, surveillance and maintenance (S&M), facility maintenance and infrastructure support, and project support activities to safely and economically maintain and monitor the ETEC site. This scope also includes options to prepare decontamination and demolition (D&D) works plans, process work plan approval through the California Department of Toxic Substance Control (DTSC), and complete the D&D for each remaining facility at the ETEC site. The purpose of this announcement is to notify interested parties about the pre-solicitation conference, site tour and industry one-on-one sessions established for the procurement and other activities associated with the procurement.

DOE plans to conduct a pre-solicitation conference, site tour and industry one-on-one sessions for this procurement. DOE has tentatively scheduled these activities to be held on September 17-19, 2013. A draft Request for Task Order Proposals (RTP) for this procurement is tentatively scheduled to be released the week of September 3, 2013. Interested parties are encouraged to review the draft RTP prior to the pre-solicitation conference, site tour and industry one-on-one sessions.

Each company who submits a request will get a specific time and day for their one-on-one session. Sessions will be no more than one hour each.

To facilitate the government's planning; please provide the name, organizational affiliation, telephone number, e-mail address and citizenship of each proposed attendee to the following email address: john.blecher@emcbc.doe.gov no later than **3:00 P.M., September, 9, 2013 EDT**. There is a limit of five representatives per company. A valid driver's license must be provided to security personnel in order to obtain entrance to the ETEC site. DOE badges will not be accepted.

Attendance at the pre-solicitation conference and site tour is not mandatory. The Government will not reimburse any interested party for expenses related to attendance at these activities.
