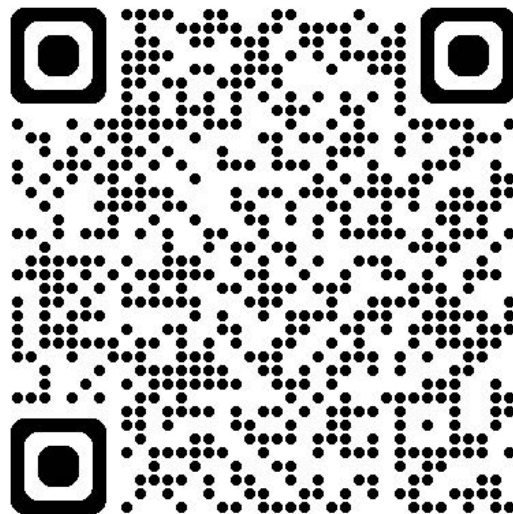

OVERVIEW
