

**Los Alamos Legacy Cleanup Completion Project (LCCP) – Post Fiscal Year 2016
Contract(s)
Industry Day Special Notice**

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Office of Environmental Management (EM) plans to conduct an Industry Day on Tuesday, March 3, 2015, in support of potential upcoming new procurement(s) for legacy cleanup projects at the Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL), hereafter referred to as “Los Alamos Legacy Cleanup Completion Project (LCCP) – Post Fiscal Year 2016 Contract(s)”. As previously announced, it is DOE-EM’s intent to enter into a separate contract with Los Alamos National Security (LANS), LLC (the current operating contractor at LANL) in the next 30 days to continue activities in support of legacy cleanup projects over the next 12-24 months at LANL. This interim contract is needed in order to continue legacy cleanup activities at LANL while the procurement activities necessary to procure the “Los Alamos LCCP – Post Fiscal Year 2016 Contract(s)” are completed over that same time period. The contract with LANS is called the “Los Alamos LCCP Bridge Contract”. The new “Los Alamos LCCP – Post Fiscal Year 2016 Contract(s)” will be for the legacy cleanup project activities that remain after the “LCCP Bridge Contract” ends in 12-24 months.

The goal of this Industry Day event is to inform interested parties of the process that will be followed to procure the new “Los Alamos LCCP – Post Fiscal Year 2016 Contract(s)” and provide an overview of the general scope for these potential new procurement(s). The Industry Day presentations will provide a site overview and technical discussion of the elements of scope for the anticipated “Los Alamos LCCP – Post Fiscal Year 2016 Contract(s)”; highlight aspects of the RFI; and encourage industry feedback to aid the Department in the development of an Acquisition Strategy.

The Industry Day will be held at the Cities of Gold Conference Center, 10-A Cities of Gold Road, Pojoaque, NM 87506 on Tuesday, March 3, 2015. Check-in will begin at 8:00 am (local time) and the meeting will begin at 9:00 am (local time). Details concerning registration to attend this event are available at the following website:

Registration for the Industry Day will close COB February 25, 2015. Pre-registration is required; walk-ins will not be permitted. Registration is limited to five (5) representatives from each company attending the Industry Day. However, if the total number requested to attend exceeds the capacity of the facility, it may be necessary to further limit attendance of personnel from each company. DOE will reply via e-mail with a registration confirmation. All expenses associated with attendance are the responsibility of the participants.

Prior to the Industry Day, DOE intends to publish a Request for Information (RFI), incorporating

the elements of scope, seeking interested parties with specialized capabilities who meet all or part of the requirements. With release of this RFI, the DOE intends to seek ideas and acquire feedback from contractors and other interested parties regarding options for innovative approaches for the division of scope elements as well as insight into contracting options to achieve the Environmental Management (EM) goals
