Los Alamos Legacy Cleanup Contract (LLCC)
Site Tour, Pre-Solicitation Conference, and Industry One-on-One Sessions
Draft Solicitation No. DE-SOL-0008109**

The purpose of this notification is to provide a clarification to the identification requirements regarding the upcoming Los Alamos Legacy Cleanup Contract (LLCC) Site Tour.

With respect to the “Registration” paragraph in the May 10, 2016, LLCC posting, DOE is providing the following clarifications:

- Submittal of Social Security Numbers is not required. Therefore, SS#'s are not being collected and any previous submittals will be deleted.
- There is no form for tour participants to fill out or submit in advance.
- For access to the site tour taking place on the Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL), visitors must provide a photo ID (driver's license from a REAL ID Act compliant state, or a passport).
 - The list of REAL ID Act non-compliant states can be found online at <https://www.dhs.gov/current-status-states-territories>
 - For individuals from REAL ID Act non-compliant states, they must provide one of the following secondary forms of identification to attend the site tour:
 - Acceptable birth certificate (State issued)
 - Certificate of Naturalization
 - Certificate of Citizenship issued by INS or its successor
 - U.S. Passport (current or expired)
 - U.S. Passport Card
 - U.S. Military ID (active duty or retired military and their dependents, and DoD civilians)
 - Federally recognized, tribal-issued photo ID
 - Permanent resident card (only with conditions met; see below)
 - A permanent resident card (green card) **will not** be an accepted form of ID for the June 7, 2016 visit unless DIVA approval is obtained and *validated* by EM prior to the visit.
 - HSPD-12 PIV card
 - Current LSSO (Local Site Specific Only) Badge issued by another DOE Organization.
