Pre-solicitation Conference and Site Tour**

DOE will conduct a pre-solicitation conference and site tour for the Moab UMTRA TAC procurement. DOE has scheduled these activities to be held on December 14th, 2016.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Draft RFP is posted to the Moab UMTRA TAC procurement website at: <https://www.emcbc.doe.gov/SEB/Moab/>. Interested parties are encouraged to review the Draft RFP prior to the pre-solicitation conference and site tour.

Attendance at the pre-solicitation conference and site tour is not mandatory and absence will not affect the Government's review of any resulting proposal positively or negatively. The Government will not reimburse any entity for expenses related to attendance at these activities. Attendees are responsible for their transportation to and from the events. No meals will be provided.

Each organization may register up to two (2) representatives for the conference and site tour.

COMMUNITY STAKEHOLDERS

DOE encourages interested community stakeholders to attend the pre-solicitation conference and site tour. Any interested community stakeholders shall be required to register as instructed below.

REGISTRATION

Pre-registration is required for all events; walk-ins will not be permitted. Register by e-mailing john.blecher@emcbc.doe.gov with the name, organizational affiliation, and position title of each proposed attendee no later than 3:00 PM Eastern Time on December 7, 2016.

The Security Guards at the access points for the Moab and Crescent Junction sites will have the list of attendees and will only allow those personnel on-site.

SECURITY ISSUES

Tour participants are required to remain with the tour group the entire time. Conference and site tour participants will be given instructions on where they are permitted to be. Cameras are permitted on site.

There are several items that are not allowed at the Moab Site or on the site tour transportation. These items include real or simulated firearms and ammunition, stun guns, alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs and drug paraphernalia, explosives, hand-held weapons, chemical irritants, and

items prohibited by state and federal law. Other items not allowed on the tour or in the conference are copying or transcription devices and electronic recording devices.

PRE-SOLICITATION CONFERENCE

The pre-solicitation conference will be held on Wednesday, December 14, 2016 in Moab, UT at 2021 N. Highway 191, Moab, UT 84532. Attendees will be directed to the conference trailer on site. Attendees should arrive at check-in by 8:50 AM (Moab, UT is in the Mountain time zone) and the meeting will begin at 9:00 AM.

DOE will provide a briefing of the Moab UMTRA TAC procurement, including discussion of specific areas of the draft RFP and the history of the Moab UMTRA Project.

Attendees are not allowed to bring recording, copying, or transcription devices into the conference room. Slides presented at the conference will be posted on the procurement website after the conference.

SITE TOUR

Immediately following the conference the first portion of the site tour will be begin (Moab, UT).

The second portion of the site tour will begin at 2:00pm MST at the Crescent Junction, UT site (physical address is 0.15 County Road 223, Thompson Springs, UT 84540). Attendees will be directed to the conference trailer on site. Attendees will be responsible for their own transportation to each site tour location.

All tour participants must be able to complete the entirety of the tour and must remain with the tour group at all times. If special accommodations are required, please identify those needs when registering for the tour, otherwise accommodations may not be provided.

Offerors are urged and expected to inspect the site where services are to be performed and satisfy themselves regarding all general and local conditions that may affect the price of performance, to the extent that the information is reasonably obtainable. In no event shall failure to inspect the site constitute grounds for a claim after contract award.

SITE TOUR- PERSONAL PROTECTION EQUIPMENT (PPE)

Hard hats, vests, and safety glasses are not a requirement for the site tour. Participants are reminded to not wear shorts and to wear sturdy, closed-toe, flat shoes suitable for walking on uneven surfaces. Sunscreen may also be necessary due to the necessary amount of walking outside for the site tour. Participants can bring their own PPE if they would like.

DOE looks forward to continued engagement with industry and other interested parties in a transparent and collaborative manner throughout the procurement process for UMTRA TAC procurement.
