SOURCES SOUGHT / REQUEST FOR INFORMATION (RFI)

Solicitation Number: **DE-SOL-0009142**

Title: **Oak Ridge Office of Environmental Management Technical Support Services**

Q1. Are you requesting only small business respond to this RFI or may any large business respond to show interest and capability?

A1. One of the intentions of the Sources Sought is to conduct market research to assist with assessing set-aside possibilities. That being said, responses are welcomed from business entities of all sizes. Please be sure to identify your business size as stated in Question #1 of the Sources Sought.

Q2. Who is the current incumbent contractor for these services?

A2. Similar type services are currently being performed for OREM by Professional Project Services, Inc.

Q3. What is the current contract number for these services?

A3. Similar type services are currently being performed under DE-SC0002373.

Q4. Would holding a prime contract with DOE OREM preclude a firm from holding this Technical Support Services contract due to OCI concerns?

A4. A prime contractor (or those fulfilling a key subcontractor role) for one of DOE OREM's primary contracts (those contracts that are not support services-type contracts) will likely preclude the contractor from holding this forthcoming Technical Support Services contract due to OCI concerns. Note that OCI determinations are made on a case-by-case basis after assessing all relevant information, proposed avoidance/mitigation plans, etc.

Q5. Can you provide the Program Manager or Technical Monitor for this effort?

A5. The PM/Technical Monitor for this effort is not yet known. Any questions related to this RFI or resulting procurement should be directed to the Contracting Officer, Travis Marshall, at travis.marshall@emcbc.doe.gov.

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A6. The correct due date and time for the capability statements is 3:00pm Eastern on Tuesday, December 8, 2015. We apologize for the discrepancy, and have corrected the FedConnect system issue.

Q7. For the capability statement responses, can the font size be smaller than 12 point in tables?

A7. On a limited basis, the font size can be smaller than 12 point in situations such as tables and graphics. We request that you utilize sound business judgment and minimize such instances.
