89.	<p>C.3.10 ON-SITE FUELING SERVICE Costs for fuel shall be charged to each using customer, including DOE, on a cost reimbursement first-in-first-out (FIFO) basis for the cost of the fuel only.</p> <p>Is fuel for ISS Contractor vehicles and generators a cost-reimbursable item or must it be included in our fixed-price estimate. If the latter, this places an extremely high, unpredictable financial risk on the contractor. Given the high volatility of fuel prices, would the government consider making fuel a reimbursable cost.</p>	<p>Fuel for the ISS Contractor's activities is part of the firm-fixed-price.</p> <p>Please note that for GSA Interagency Fleet Management System (IFMS) vehicles, GSA vehicle rates are based on a monthly lease and mileage charge, which includes all maintenance and fuel expenses. These costs are reimbursable under Section C.4.5, IFMS Vehicles.</p> <p>The Contractor will be responsible for fuel costs for DOE-owned vehicles/equipment that are provided to the Contractor, Contractor-owned vehicles, mowers, and other equipment as part of the firm-fixed-price. While not an assumption of future fuel costs since fuel usage will be dependent on the Contractor's technical approach, historical fuel costs have generally accounted for less than 1% of total contract costs.</p>
