

Site Tour for the Portsmouth Infrastructure Support Services Request for Proposal No. DE-SOL-0006421

The Department of Energy (DOE) will conduct a Site Tour of the Portsmouth Site on Wednesday January 7, 2015 for parties interested in the Portsmouth Infrastructure Support Services procurement. Additional site tours may be made available on Thursday, January 8th if necessary. The final Request for Proposal (RFP) for this procurement was released December 09, 2014 and is posted at www.emcbc.doe.gov/SEB/PortsmouthISS/index.php.

Check-in for the tour will begin at 8:00am at the Ohio State University (OSU) Endeavor Center Research and Development Building Auditorium located at 1864 Shyville Road, Piketon OH 45661. The tour is expected to begin at 8:30am after a short security briefing/orientation. Tour busses will depart from and return to the OSU center and will transport participants around the Portsmouth Site. The site tour will be an extensive tour, including entry in various facilities, and may include a significant amount of walking and climbing of stairs. The tour is expected to last approximately 6 hours. Participants will be allowed to bring water on the bus during the tour.

No recording, copying or transcription devices will be allowed in the conference room or tour bus by attendees. DOE may record the Site Tour. Any materials presented at the Site Tour, including the list of attendees, will be subsequently posted on the Portsmouth Infrastructure Support Services procurement website at <https://www.emcbc.doe.gov/SEB/PortsmouthISS>

You must bring a State or Federal Government Issued photo ID to attend the tour (driver's license, military ID, passport, Federal agency site ID, etc.). Only U.S. citizens will be allowed to participate in the tour. Any individual requesting site access that presents a driver's license or state identification card from a non-REAL ID compliant state will be required to provide a second form of identification that is not subject to the REAL ID requirements. Non-REAL ID compliant states as of the time of this posting are Alaska, American Samoa, Arizona, Louisiana, Maine, Massachusetts, Minnesota, New York, Oklahoma, and Washington. People with identification from these states/jurisdictions will need to present an alternate identification to be granted admission to any areas of the Paducah site that requires a photo-ID. In addition to a REAL ID compliant state driver's license or state identification card, primary forms of identity source documents include: U.S. Passport or U.S. Passport Card, U.S. Military ID card, U.S. Military Dependent's ID card, Enhanced driver's license or Enhanced ID-card issued by the states of Minnesota, New York, or Washington (and will be clearly marked as "Enhanced"), or a PIV card (HSPD-12 card). If a secondary form of identity documentation is provided, the name on the second form must match the name on the non-REAL ID. It is recommended that all participants dress casually and wear comfortable walking shoes (no open-toed shoes or high heels). Safety shoes are not required; however, shoes worn shall be closed-toe, made of

leather or other substantive materials (not cloth). If special accommodations are required, please notify DOE when registering for the tour.

Security requirements dictate that all participants remain with the tour group for the duration of the tour. There are also several prohibited/controlled items that are not allowed at the Portsmouth Site. These items are firearms or dangerous weapons, alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs and paraphernalia, chemical irritants, and items prohibited by state and federal law. Other items not allowed on the tour are copying devices, electronic recording devices, cameras, radios, cellular telephones, blackberries (an emergency number will be available), and knives with blades more than three inches long. Contraband brought to the Portsmouth Site will be confiscated.

Please be aware that all hand carried items (packages, briefcases, handbags, purses, etc.) will be subject to inspection. The DOE will not be responsible for securing any items during the tour so it is recommended they be locked in your vehicle. Please keep hand-carried items to a minimum.

Questions will not be entertained during the tour. The site tour is for informational purposes only. A prepared script will be used for the site tour and will be available on the procurement web site after the tour is conducted. Any statements and/or representations made during the tour are not binding in any way on DOE or in any respect to the Portsmouth Infrastructure Support Services procurement. Tour participants are cautioned that the ONLY controlling documents/information will be the Final RFP and any amendments issued henceforth.

Registration Information

Contractors or contractor team arrangements that are seriously interested in submitting a proposal as a prime contractor lead entity in response to the Final RFP are requested to participate in the pre-proposal conference briefing and site tour. Attendance for this event is strictly limited to not more than **three** individuals for each prime contractor or contractor team arrangement seriously interested in submitting a proposal, including key subcontractor and/or teaming partner personnel.

Requests for participation must be provided to PORTSISS@emcbc.doe.gov by 5:00 PM Eastern Time on Wednesday, December 31, 2014. DOE must have a completed Site Tour Registration Sheet (attached) for each visitor.

Due to security concerns and the amount of time necessary to process requests from foreign nationals, only U.S. citizens may attend the events. If you register but cannot attend, please notify wilmari.delgado@emcbc.doe.gov as soon as possible.
