Savannah River Site (SRS) Liquid Waste Services
Supplemental Site Tour
Draft Solicitation No. DE-SOL-0008913**

DOE will conduct a supplemental site tour for the SRS Liquid Waste Services procurement on June 29, 2016. The supplemental site tour is anticipated to include certain facilities that were toured on April 19, 2016, as well as the Tank Farms Consolidated Control Room, the Effluent Treatment Facility, the Salt Waste Processing Facility, the Saltstone Facility, and the Savannah River National Laboratory (SRNL).

SUPPLEMENTAL SITE TOUR SCHEDULE AND LOGISTICS

On the day of the tour, participants should arrive at check-in at the SRS Badge Office, SRS Road 1, building 703-46A, between 8:00 AM and 8:30 AM to allow time for badging, safety briefing, and security inspections. Following check-in, all participants will board a commercial bus at the Badge Office for transportation on the site tour. The bus transporting the participants will depart for the tour promptly at 8:45 AM. Participants will be required to attend the full day of the tour. Lunch will be provided and will require purchase for \$10.00 that will be collected in the morning of the tour before boarding the bus.

The tour will consist of both indoor and outdoor travel on foot. Please ensure you wear natural fiber clothing, including long pants and sturdy leather closed toe shoes. Please dress appropriately for the weather conditions that day; hats, sunglasses, and umbrellas are acceptable items. Safety shoes are not required; however, shoes worn shall be closed-toe, above the ankle if possible, and made of leather or other substantive materials (not cloth). If special accommodations are required, please identify those needs when registering for the tour.

The tour will include walking on uneven surfaces and climbing of multiple flights of stairs. All tour participants must be able to complete the entirety of the tour and must remain with the tour group at all times. The tour will conclude back at the SRS Badge Office at approximately 4:00 PM.

No questions will be answered by DOE during the site tour. However, any participant questions can be submitted to DOE via note cards during the site tour, and answers will be subsequently posted by DOE to the procurement website.

UPDATE (06/09/16): Long pants are required and must cover the ankles. Additionally, shirts must have sleeves that are 4 inches or longer. Also, tennis shoes are not acceptable. Hot weather conditions are anticipated for the site tour, and water will be provided during the tour.

SUPPLEMENTAL SITE TOUR SECURITY ISSUES

Security requirements dictate that all participants remain with the tour group for the duration of the tour. There are also several prohibited items that are not allowed at SRS. These items include real or simulated firearms and ammunition, stun guns, alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs and paraphernalia, explosives, hand-held weapons, chemical irritants, and items prohibited by state and federal law. Other items not allowed on the tour include copying or transcription devices, electronic recording devices, cameras, radios, and knives with blades more than three inches long. Contraband brought to SRS will be confiscated. Government issued and/or personal cellular phones are permitted on the tour with the exception of SRNL where these items must be left on the bus. **However, pictures and recording of audio or video are strictly prohibited.**

Please be aware that all hand carried items (packages, briefcases, handbags, purses, etc.) will be inspected by security prior to boarding the bus. DOE will not be responsible for securing any items during the tour. Please keep hand-carried items to a minimum.

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SUPPLEMENTAL SITE TOUR REGISTRATION

Additionally, any foreign nationals requesting registration for the tour must also complete and return the form titled, "Information Request for International Visitors: Access Approval Form to U.S. Department of Energy" located on the procurement website. Two valid forms of identification must be provided to security personnel in order to obtain entrance to the site for the site tour, and a listing of acceptable forms of identification is included on the procurement website. Further, all tour participants are required to review the brochure titled, "Safe and Secure: The Savannah River Site Point of Entry Briefing" located on the procurement website prior to the tour date.

Pre-registration is required and walk-ins will not be permitted. There is a limit of two (2) representatives per company for the supplemental site tour. DOE will provide tentative confirmation of registration requests upon receipt, and final confirmation of registration requests is anticipated to be provided by June 17, 2016.

Attendance at the supplemental site tour is not mandatory, and the Government will not reimburse any contractor for expenses related to attendance at these activities.
