

Savannah River Site Liquid Waste Requirement
Special Notice – Industry Day and One-on-One Sessions
September 29, 2015

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Office of Environmental Management (EM) plans to hold an Industry Day and One-on-One sessions on October 14-15, 2015, in support the upcoming procurement for liquid waste services at the Savannah River Site (SRS). The current liquid waste contract at SRS expires on June 30, 2017, and is a major component of the overall SRS work scope and contracting structure. The goal of this Industry Day event is to inform interested parties of the process that will be followed to procure the liquid waste requirement, and to provide an overview of the major Elements of Scope. The Industry Day presentations will provide a site overview and technical discussion of the major Elements of Scope for the anticipated liquid waste contract, and encourage industry feedback to aid the Department in the development of the Acquisition Plan. Industry day presentations will be available on the procurement website not later than October 9, 2015.

The Industry Day will be held at the Doubletree Augusta Hilton Hotel on October 14, 2015, located at 2651 Perimeter Pkwy, Augusta, GA 30909. Check-in will begin at 8:00 am (local time) and the meeting will begin at 9:00 am (local time). The event is anticipated to conclude at approximately 3:00 pm (local time).

DOE will hold one-on-one sessions to obtain constructive input from interested firms regarding the liquid waste procurement. The one-on-one sessions are provided as an opportunity for interested parties to present their thoughts and suggestions on the procurement, including but not limited to the questions included in the Request for Information (RFI). DOE will consider all input, will not attribute the input received to any other participant, and will protect any information identified as business sensitive. DOE is not requesting and will not accept any company marketing material. Any presentation materials shall be in hard copy, as computer equipment will not be provided nor allowed. Furthermore, no recording, copying or transcription devices will be allowed during the one-on-one sessions by attendees.

The one-on-one sessions will be held on October 15, 2015, at the Doubletree Augusta Hilton Hotel. The one-on-one sessions will be scheduled in 30 minute increments on a first come first serve basis.

As referenced above, DOE published an RFI on September 22, 2015. With release of this RFI, the DOE intends to seek ideas and acquire feedback from contractors and other interested parties regarding options for innovative approaches as well as insight into contracting options to achieve the Environmental Management (EM) liquid waste goals. Responses to the RFI are due to DOE by October 21, 2015.

Registration for the Industry Day and one-on-one sessions will close on October 8, 2015. Pre-registration is required and walk-ins will not be permitted. Registration is limited to five (5) representatives from each company attending the Industry Day and one-on-one sessions. However, if the total number requested to attend exceeds the capacity of the facility for the Industry Day, it may be necessary to further limit attendance of personnel from each company.

DOE will reply via e-mail with a registration confirmation. All expenses associated with attendance are the responsibility of the participants.
