PRE-SOLICITATION INFORMATION

The Department of Energy (DOE) Office of Environmental Management will provide pre-solicitation information and conduct one-on-one sessions for the Savannah River Operations Acquisition. These activities are for informational purposes only. Note that an in-person or virtual pre-solicitation conference will not be conducted at this time. All pre-solicitation information including a presentation regarding the SRS Operations Acquisition and related information specific to the Draft Request for Proposal (RFP) is available on the procurement website at <https://www.emcbc.doe.gov/SEB/SRSOperations>

VIRTUAL SITE TOUR

There will not be an in-person Site Tour for the Savannah River Operations Acquisition due to COVID-19 restrictions. However, if conditions allow at the time of Final RFP issuance, a site tour may be offered at that time. Instead, DOE has provided a virtual tour alternative. This consists of a prerecorded video. Microsoft PowerPoint presentations specific to areas of scope are also provided. Registration for the virtual tour is not necessary. Interested parties, community partners and regulators seeking additional information concerning this opportunity may provide a name, organization name, and contact information to the Contracting Officer for posting to the procurement website if so desired. Such connections are encouraged, and may be emailed to the Contracting Officer, Paul Smith (SRSOperations@emcbc.doe.gov) any time during the proposal preparation period.

None of the information stated or presented should be construed as a revision to the Draft RFP unless issued in an amendment. Information provided is at a summary level and is subject to change. The written terms and conditions of the Final RFP, once released, will govern over any information provided. Prospective Offerors shall prepare their proposals based solely on the requirements specified in the Final RFP, and in any accompanying amendments, if issued. Prospective Offerors shall be responsible for reviewing beta.sam.gov and the procurement website regularly for information, notices, and updates regarding the Final RFP. Operations depicted in this Site Tour's contents are not intended to define Final RFP, Record of Decision, or Remedial Action (Inspection) Plan requirements.

ONE-ON-ONE SESSIONS – MAY 11-12 & MAY 13, 2021 IF NEEDED

DOE will hold one-on-one sessions to obtain constructive input from interested parties, community partners and regulators regarding the Savannah River Operations Acquisition procurement. The one-on-one sessions are provided as an opportunity for interested parties, community partners and regulators to present their thoughts and suggestions on the procurement including, but not limited to, the questions included in the cover letter to the Draft RFP. DOE will consider all input, will not attribute the input received to any other participant, and will

protect any information identified as business sensitive. **DOE is not requesting and will not accept any company marketing material.** Computer equipment will not be provided. Furthermore, no recording, copying or transcription devices will be allowed during the one-on-one sessions by attendees. Only DOE may record these sessions.

One-on-one sessions will be held via WebEx. DOE will contact each participant via email with the date and time of their scheduled session. The time allotted for each one on one session will be limited to 30 minutes and will be on a first come first serve basis. DOE can assign the WebEx “Presenter” role to the interested party; however, any presentation materials shall also be emailed to SRSOperations@emcbc.doe.gov in advance of the one-on-one session. DOE will contact each registered participant via email with the specific WebEx information for their scheduled one on one session.

Attendance at a one on one session is voluntary. Neither attendance nor non-attendance will be a factor in DOE’s evaluation of an Offeror’s proposal. The Government will not reimburse any entity for expenses related to participation in these sessions.

ONE-ON-ONE SESSION REGISTRATION

A completed registration form is needed for each interested party / community partner / regulatory agency and shall be submitted to the Contracting Officer by 2:00 PM ET, **May 5, 2021**. Please submit only one form per entity. Participation is limited to six (6) individuals per entity. Pre-registration is required, and no additional email addresses/registrants will be added to the WebEx after the registration deadline. Each participant shall log in to the WebEx using their full name and affiliation. DOE reserves the right to remove any participant from the meeting.
