

HANFORD SITE RECREATIONAL POLICY

The Hanford Site, defined as the federal property north of the Wye Barricade and the 300 and 400 areas, is covered by this policy. The policy is applicable to activities that are unrelated to an employee's specific job assignment or approved research activities.

While the Department of Energy encourages all employees to maintain a healthy life style that includes recreational exercise, it is necessary that some limitations and/or requirements be placed on these activities while on the Hanford Site. The following limitations on recreational activities apply at all times on the Hanford Site:

- Recreational activities off designated roadways or paved pathways are not permitted.
- Bicycles used for commuting or for performance of assigned duties are allowed on contractor approved routes. Recreational bicycle riding and other roller sport activities are not permitted.
- Recreational activities, except roller sports, are limited to those approved by the facility manager, within designated areas during daylight hours and in accordance with company policies.
- Recreational activities on Gable Mountain, Gable Butte, or Rattlesnake Mountain, including on designated roadways are not permitted,
- Activities in any posted areas must comply with the posting,
- Appropriate safety equipment shall be used and activities must be in compliance with applicable laws and regulations.

Reporting of injuries or illness that occur to employees shall comply with 29 CFR 1904.5(b)(2).
