Synopsis / Pre-Solicitation Notice
Department of Energy Low-Level Mixed Low-Level Waste Treatment Acquisition

Within 30 to 60 days from the date this notice is published, the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) anticipates issuing a Request for Proposal (RFP), DE-SOL-0006499, to receive, handle, and treat Low Level Waste (LLW) and Mixed Low Level Waste (MLLW). These wastes may also include liquid and solid Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) regulated waste e.g., polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs), asbestos, etc. Also DOE seeks, under this requirement, services such as: Treatment Storage Disposal Facility (TSDF) Authorized Release for Directed Disposal including Bulk Survey for Release (BSFR), Restricted and Unrestricted Recycling/Reuse, Low Activity Waste (LAW) Services, Ancillary Services, and support in establishing authorized release limits.

Waste material to be treated under this requirement originates from Federal activities and includes clean-up, remediation, demolition, and operations waste, and or waste under the DOE's purview. The LLW and MLLW Treatment Services supports the EM mission of safely completing the cleanup of the environmental legacy brought about from five decades of nuclear weapons development and government-sponsored nuclear energy research.

It is DOE's intent to issue one or more Basic Ordering Agreements (BOAs) as a result of this RFP to firms whose proposals are in accordance with the terms and conditions of the solicitation and meet all the technical acceptability criteria listed in Section M. The issuance of the BOA(s) is expected in or around the 2nd quarter of fiscal year 2015.

The period of performance for the BOA(s) is five (5) years from the date of issuance with no associated option periods. Firm fixed price task orders will be issued off the BOA(s) for treatment of specific waste types and quantities.

This RFP is issued on a full-and-open, unrestricted basis. The North American Industrial Classification System (NAICS) code for this effort is 562211 – Hazardous Waste Treatment and Disposal, Size Standard \$35.5 Million (annual receipts).

All responsible sources may submit an offer by the due date to be listed in the RFP. Any clarifying questions should be submitted in writing via the e-mail address at llwmlwtreatmentservices@emcbc.doe.gov. Questions regarding the RFP, once it is issued, will have a cut-off date specified in Section L of the RFP.
