Synopsis
Paducah Infrastructure Support Services Procurement

This notice is considered to be a synopsis in accordance with FAR Subpart 5.2 for the Paducah Infrastructure Support Services (PAD Infrastructure) Procurement.

Within 15 to 60 days from the date that this notice is published, the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) anticipates the issuance of a Request for Proposal (RFP), 89303319REM000057, for the PAD Infrastructure Procurement at the Paducah Site near Paducah, Kentucky.

DOE requires a Contractor to provide infrastructure services under this acquisition to include (but not limited to) surveillance, maintenance and repair and construction/replacement of facilities; janitorial services; grounds maintenance, snow removal, and pest control; roadway/parking lot maintenance; computer and telecommunications services, fleet management, real property management and document control; safeguards and security, environmental safety, health and quality program, training services; mail services; shipping and receiving; and other activities and support to DOE. The new contract resulting from this acquisition will replace the Swift and Staley-Paducah Infrastructure Contract, DE-EM0003733, which will expire September 30, 2020.

This procurement will be a total small business set aside. The Government does not intend to acquire a commercial item or service using FAR Part 12. The North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) code for this requirement is 561210, Facilities Support Services, with a size standard of \$41.5 million.

The infrastructure support services to be acquired will be performed at the Paducah Site, which is located on a federal reservation in Western Kentucky, approximately 8 miles west of Paducah,

Kentucky, and 3.5 miles south of the Ohio River. The Paducah Site is situated on approximately 3,556 acres divided as follows:

- 748 acres within a fenced limited security area;
- Approximately 822 acres of uninhabited area surrounding the plant area; and
- 1,986 acres licensed to the Kentucky Department of Fish and Wildlife as part of the West Kentucky Wildlife Management Area.
