Savannah River Site (SRS) Integrated Mission Completion Contract (IMCC) Procurement

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) plans to issue the Draft Performance Work Statement (PWS), Section C, for the SRS IMCC procurement, Solicitation No. 89303319REM000055. The SRS IMCC contractor will provide a comprehensive risk-based methodology to the legacy cleanup project, such as the dispositioning of radioactive liquid waste through the Salt Waste Processing Facility followed by vitrification of the high activity component at the site's Defense Waste Processing Facility and using existing SRS facilities to receive, store, and disposition aluminum-clad Spent Nuclear Fuel. Critical scope covered under this contract includes, but is not limited to, Project Management and Support Services, Liquid Waste Stabilization/Disposition and may include Nuclear Materials Management and Stabilization.

A Draft Request for Proposals (RFP) will not be issued for the SRS IMCC procurement, only a Final RFP will be released. The Final RFP for SRS IMCC will consider the industry feedback on the Idaho Clean-Up Project (ICP) Draft RFP, Solicitation No. 89303319REM000034, since the non-scope sections are materially consistent. The SRS IMCC Final RFP will reflect a streamlined approach to the evaluation factors under the End State Contracting Model (ESCM). The ESCM will continue to consist of a competitive contract award through a 2-step process utilized to procure the best value partner to openly negotiate future task orders with the right end state requirements and regulatory framework that appropriately shares risk following contract award.

DOE intends to conduct a pre-proposal conference and site tour for this procurement once the Final RFP is released. Interested parties are encouraged to review the Special Notice and Draft Performance Work Statement (PWS), Section C. At this time, DOE has tentatively scheduled these activities to be held in April 2020.
