



SUBJECT: Retract Delegation of Acquisition Executive Authority for Capital Asset Projects at the Nevada National Security Site and Los Alamos National Laboratory

Senior management at the Office of Environmental Management (EM) recently reassessed the manner in which EM capital asset projects at National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA) site offices are administered and executed. Retaining the Acquisition Executive (AE) authority at EM Headquarters, rather than at the EM Consolidated Business Center, will streamline EM project administration and decisionmaking at NNSA sites. Therefore, I hereby retract delegation of AE authority for projects with a Total Project Cost (TPC) of less than \$100 million from you as Director, Consolidated Business Center, at the following sites:

- Nevada National Security Site
- Los Alamos National Laboratory

Your delegation of AE authority for all EM capital asset projects with a TPC of less than \$100 million remains valid at the following small sites:

- West Valley Demonstration Project
- Energy Technology Engineering Center
- Moab UMTRA Project
- Argonne National Laboratory
- Brookhaven National Laboratory
- Stanford Linear Accelerator Center
- Separation Process Research Unit
- Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory
